WAIVER PETITION FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE

For School & Student Services (SSS) to provide your school an appropriate estimate of the amount you can contribute to school expenses, all available financial resources are to be disclosed.

In the case of divorced or separated parents, or parents who have never been married, we should still consider the financial resources of BOTH parents for the school to offer a proper award. Therefore, SSS best practice requires BOTH parents to submit a financial aid application to the school with copies of their tax forms, schedules, and W-2's for the year that just ended.

Because SSS considers that both parents have an obligation to support their child's education, the financial situations of both parents are taken into consideration. The school shouldn't be bound by the assertion of one parent or a court ruling that he/she is not responsible for the student's educational expenses even in the case of divorce and remarriage. If either parent remarries, we shall bear in mind the obligations of that parent to his or her new family. If the parent with custody remarries, we shall consider the resources of the step-parent; however, we shall also bear in mind the obligations of the step-parent to his or her natural children.

At this time, your school has indicated we can waive the noncustodial parent requirement. For the school and their internal records, this form must be completed as part of your financial aid application. Provide the school with as much information as possible and an explanation of parental situation (i.e. The noncustodial parent's whereabouts are unknown; The noncustodial parent has no contact, and has not had any contact, with the applicant over a period of years; The noncustodial parent provides no financial support to the student.).
