LIFEGUARD / SWIM INSTRUCTOR

POSITION OVERVIEW:

LIFEGUARDS/SWIM INSTRUCTORS play a dual role in fostering safe and fun pool activities. Lifeguards'/Swim Instructors' primary responsibility is to ensure the safety and well-being of all campers during swim instruction and free swim. In addition, lifeguards provide individual and small-group swim lessons to help campers become more confident and competent swimmers.

CERTIFICATIONS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- · Completed 9th Grade or older (by June 10)
- Current lifeguard certification (by June 10)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Be in attendance all day (as assigned) and every day that camp is in session
- · Work with the Summer Director and Pool Operator during pre-season training to set up the pool area
- · Assist in the closing of pool and storage of pool equipment at the end of the season
- · Maintain good public relations with campers, staff, and families
- · Practice discretion at all times in conversations with campers and other staff
- · Attend preseason staff training, including in-pool sessions
- · Periodically assist with lunch and carpool duties
- · Other reasonable duties as assigned by the Summer Director and/or Pool Operator

ESSENTIAL QUALITIES:

- Ability to communicate and work with other staff and provide necessary instruction to campers
- Abilitiy to observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate behavior management techniques
- · Ability to work with different age and skill levels
- · Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to activities
- · Possess strength and endurance required to maintain constant supervision of campers

WORK SCHEDULE:

Park runs camps from June II-July 26. Lifeguard/Swim Instructor applicants should be available from 8:15 a.m.-4:15 p.m. during the weeks that they are scheduled to work. Applicants should indicate their interest in the following weeks when completing the online application.

- Weeks I and 2 (June II-June 2I, no camp on June 10 or June 19)
- Weeks 3-7 (June 24-July 26, no camp on July 4)
- Weeks I-7 (June II-26, no camp on June IO, June I9, and July 4)
