
SEVENTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2025-2026

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- One large, sturdy zippered pencil case*
- Pencils (mechanical or standard)
- Blue or black pens
- 2 red pens
- Highlighters (at least 2 colors)
- 4 dry erase markers

- Scissors
- Ruler (in & cm); sturdy plastic, with holes

PLANNER

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE)

CALCULATORS

7th and 8th graders are allowed to use calculators frequently during math class. If your child already has a TI-84, they can continue to use that calculator and it will last them through upper school and college. If you are planning to purchase a calculator for your child, we suggest a smaller, lighter, and less expensive option, the Casio fx-991cw, but this is <u>not</u> a required device. We will have basic calculators available in the classroom for students to borrow while they are in class, but it is often more convenient for them to have their own device both in class and for homework.
