TECH REQUIREMENTS

MATH

- *Your child will receive a quadrule from their teacher. You do NOT need to purchase this.*

- [12" ruler](#); translucent/transparent, unbreakable; both inches and centimeters
- **Calculator.** If your child already has a TI-83 or TI-84 calculator, they can continue to use that and it will last them through Upper School and college. If you are planning to purchase a calculator for your child, we suggest the [TI-30XS](#) - a smaller, lighter, and less expensive option.
